2023-2024 NDSS Semester 1 Examination Schedule

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Students must attend examinations as scheduled. Examinations can only be rescheduled in the case of a conflict (ie. two exams for one student scheduled at the same time). Travel should not be scheduled during the examination period. Any questions regarding attendance for the examination period should be directed to school administration.
- In the case of a conflict, students should speak with a member of administration before the exam schedule begins. One examination will be rescheduled to an alternate agreeable time at the discretion of the classroom teachers and administration.
- Any students with an Individual Education Plan (IEP) should discuss personal accommodations with each classroom teacher and Ms. Kinney (Head of Student Support).
- If buses are cancelled due to inclement weather, exams scheduled on that day will be rescheduled to the next exam day. Subsequent exams in the exam schedule will also be rescheduled to the next exam day. For example, if buses are cancelled on Friday, January 26th, Friday's exams will be held on Monday, January 29th. Monday's exams would be held on Tuesday, January 30th, Tuesdays exams would be held on Wednesday, January 31st, and Wednesdays exams would be held on Thursday, February 1st.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXAM DAY

- Junior exams are 1.5 hours in length; Senior exams are 2 hours in length. Students must remain in the exam room for at least 1 hour.
- Students should report to the location of their exam 10 minutes prior to the start time.
- Students should bring textbooks for textbook return during the exam period.
- Cell phones and smart watches will not be permitted in exam rooms.
- Only electronic devices as outlined in IEP's will be permitted in exam rooms.
- Students will not be permitted to be in the halls during exams.
- Bus transportation will run on exam days. There is no mid-day bus. Students with only one exam are welcome to be in the cafeteria or library during the other half of the day.
